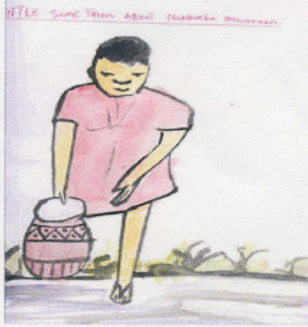


How often do you go to the village stream to collect water?

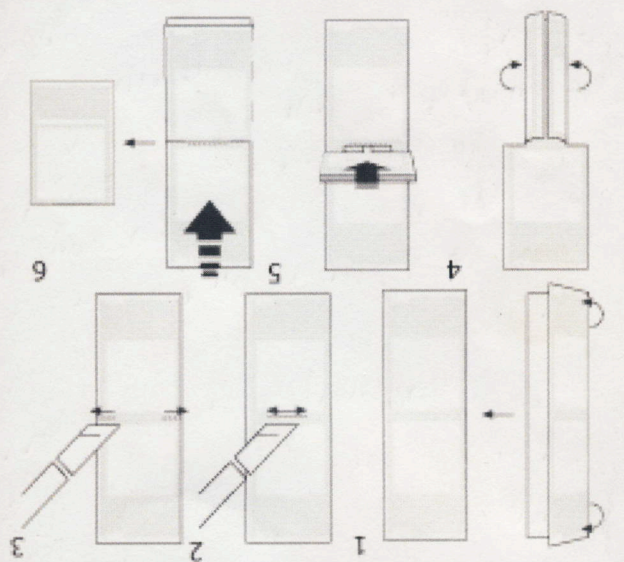

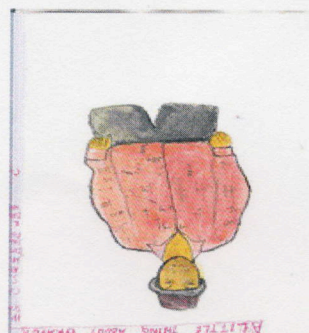

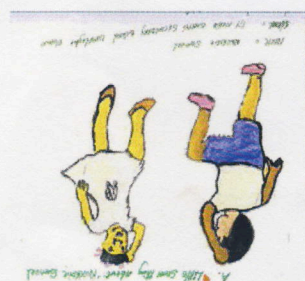
